The small print - i.e., policies you need to be aware of.

-PAPB Policy for Covid

Out of an abundance of caution and a desire to protect our members and our group, Plein Air Palm Beach is instituting COVID protocol policy for all in person events. The policy is based on the recommendations from the CDC for community groups https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/community/organizations/index.html and the Florida Health Covid response https://floridahealthcovid19.gov/prevention/

- 1. **WEAR A FACE MASK** at all times when others are present **no exceptions**.
- 2. **PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING** by keeping at least 6 ft away from others.
- 3. MEET OUTDOORS if possible
- 4. Perform health screenings before attending an in-person meetup. Check for symptoms (cough, chills, muscle pain, sore throat, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, loss of sense of taste or smell, congestion or runny nose, cramping or diarrhea, fatigue, fever (temperature higher than 100.4) Stay at home if you feel ill with any of the above symptoms.
- 4. **Stay home and quarantine for 14 days if you have had close contact** with a person who has been diagnosed with Covid-19 from the last day of contact with the person who tested positive.
- 5. If you discover you have had close contact to someone with COVID, or are diagnosed with COVID, please call your doctor. Also, please notify PAPB by emailing pleinairpalmbeach@gmail.com. This is for Covid tracking notification. The meetup rsvp will be used as our list for Covid tracking.
